Ward Priorities

Indiscriminate parking

- You highlighted parking as a problem locally, the following was recorded regarding parking issues during the month of August 2018.

There have been no reports of indiscriminate parking during the month of September 2018. Routine patrols will continue to be carried out and any vehicles reported or seen parked illegally will be dealt with robustly.

Speeding/Road Traffic

There have been no reports of excessive speeding during the month of September 2018. Police checks will remain ongoing and will take place within the Borders at specific areas where there has been concern regarding excessive speed and highlighted accident areas.

Rural thefts

There have been no recorded incidents of theft by housebreaking from during the month of September 2018. Residents are encouraged to remain vigilant and report any suspicious activity.

Other Incidents of note/relevant Community Council information.

In addition to the incidents listed above relating to the ward priorities the following incidents are also of note –

06/09 – Edinburgh Rd, Lauder, male arrested for drink driving.
10/09 – The Orchard, report of theft, enquires ongoing.
11/09 – Brownsmuir Park, Lauder, report of bogus builder, enquires ongoing.
19/09 – Edinburgh Rd, Lauder, reports of fallen trees in surrounding areas.
25/09 – Edinburgh Rd, Lauder, report of bogus builder, enquires ongoing.
28/09 – Lauder Primary School, youths causing a disturbance, enquires ongoing.

Residents are encouraged to be vigilant and report any suspicious activity to Police Scotland. If possible ensure that your property and vehicles are securely locked and that all valuable equipment is out of sight!

Police responded to 38 calls during the month of September 2018, these vary from anti-social incidents, theft and road traffic related offences.
